1.1 RNTCP mandate	There is an unmet need for improvement of Advocacy, Communication and Soci Mobilization (ACSM) to support ongoing TB control efforts. The PPP partner will be expected to coordinate with district RNTCP units to implement a minimum set of advocacy, communication are social mobilization interventions in a district by themselves.					
1.2 Cooperation from NGO	Implementing partners can include 1. Panchayati Raj institutions (PRI) 2. Self Help Groups (SHG) 3. Faith- based organizations, 4. Community based organizations, 5. Different Local Clubs, Schools, Colleges 6. Different Government & private office Staffs also to be involved 7. Other NGOs Etc. The activities should reach an area with a minimum of 1,00,000 population, but preferably should cover 10,00,000 (1 million) population or greater. 1. Plan and undertake a series of ACSM activities in consultation with the District Health Society and in close coordination with District TB Officer or representative deputed by him/her and as per the plan submitted under the partnership option. 2. Submit annual work plan to the District Health Society apprising them of specific ACSM activities to the carried out in the year.					
	3. Involve the DTO or a representative deputed by him to observe ACSM Activity planned by the PPP partner. Key opinion makers in the area and peoples representatives should be					

invited for the activities.

- 4. The PPP partner would submit separate detailed report of each ACSM activity carried out in the quarter along with the photographs and other related documents of the activities.
- 5. The activities planned should be based on the need assessment, programme performance and should be liked to work plan submitted.
- Reproduce good quality communication materials, ideally using prototype materials obtained from the District/ RNTCP website, which can the adapted for the local language and context if necessary.
- 7. The Key messages of RNTCP should not be changed and the materials need to the approved by the DTO

1.3 Grant in Aid

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Specific results

Grant in AID- Yearly

- 1. Rs. 25,000 per 1,00,000 population per year or on pro-rata basis.
- 2. The PPP partner will be expected to undertake certain minimum no of activities every month. i.e.
- a) Community meeting at least one with 30-50 or more pop.
- b) Peer support group meeting at least One
- c) Patient providers meeting with at least one with 20-30 participants
- d) IEC Meeting with High School students at least One
- e) IEC Meeting with any Office Staff at least One (Government or Private) office.
- f) Street plays or rally at least One
- g) To arrange IEC and propaganda in any public gatherings such as Melas, Religion occasion, local Haats etc.
- h) Display the prescribed IEC Materials in all possible sites under their Jurisdiction.
