Notice for Expression of Interest for "Contact Tracing Scheme" from NGO

Expression of Interest is invited from eligible Non Government Organisations for partnership with District Health & Family Welfare Samity (RNTCP). Eligible Non Government Organisations (NGOs) are invited to submit proposals for partnership to support Revised National Tuberculosis Control Programme for "**Contact tracing**" scheme.

Section 1: Backgr	
1.1 RNTCP mandate	There is an unmet need for improvement of RNTCP recommended screening of all Household contacts of Smear Positive Pulmonary TB Cases for early detection of cases.
1.2 Cooperation from NGO	1. The NGO volunteer will visit the DMCs & collect information about Sputum Smear Positive TB Patients who are:
	a. Registered in the Current month, when the NGO will be engaged & the patient will be registered month-wise, till the end of 12 months from the month of engagement.
	b. Registered for the period of previous 1 year from the month of engagement of NGO.
	2. The NGO volunteer will visit the patient's house as per List of Registered Sputum Positive Pulmonary TB patients. Identify the contacts, assess them for symptoms, counsel the family members & hand over a sputum cup to those with symptoms & request them to collect morning sample of the sputum on a specified day
	3. On that specified day visit again & collect the morning sputum & at the same time will collect one spot sputum also.
	4. The NGO volunteer will carry both the samples to the DMC following the RNTCP Norms maintaining a sputum collection Transportation Register.
	5. The NGO volunteer will have to check all the family members positively, twice in a year at every 6 months interval, for every sputum positive Pulmonary TB case.
	6. The NGO volunteer must have to maintain one Contact Tracing Register as attached.

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	 The NGO volunteer will be allowed to screen the surrounding families of the TB Patients 8 to detect the Presumptive TB Cases & Sputum examination
1.3 Grant in Aid & Specific results	 Must submit report in specific format provided by DTO Rs. 30 for home visit per Sp +/ Microbiologically Confirmed Pulmonary TB Patient per year. Rs. 35 (10+25) per sample for sputum collection & Transportation, with a condition that 3% of the suspect must have to detect as Sputum Positive TB Patient. If less, then the payment will be on prorate basis. Rs. 100 for each New TB patient identified by Contact Tracing. 15% of the above total will be paid to the NGO as Administrative cost. The payment will be made on Quarterly basis after verification of Bills submitted by NGO, by DTO
