Please note:

- In primary care facilities, service of paediatrician is not available excepting those identified as CEmOC centre. Primary resuscitation measures may be undertaken by Medical Officer based on Standard treatment guidelines as prescribed by Dept. Of H&FW, Govt. of West Bengal. Radiant heat warmer can be handled even by Nursing staff. Glucometer may be kept in the ward/LR. Diagnostic facility like haemogram, BT/CT,ESR may be done at RH/BPHC where laboratory technologist is posted.
- In Secondary care facilities, where SNCU is established then the medicine and equipments marked for tertiary care may be made available there provided trained service providers are available.
- Where CT/MRI and other diagnostic facilities are available on PPP mode, free services over the counter should be ensured with reimbursement to private partner from RKS or any other fund available with the hospital authority on submission of authorized requisition.
