Subject: Screening of Folk Troupes for generating awareness on HIV/ AIDS

WBSAP&CS is going to empanel from amongst Folk Troupes empanelled under the Dept. of I&CA, Govt. of West Bengal or Song & Drama Division, Govt. of India or any other Govt. Dept. to generate mass awareness on HIV/ AIDS and allied issues through different popular folk forms of West Bengal. Advertisements seeking application from the desirous troupes have already been published in Bengali (Bartaman & Sambad Pratidin), Hindi (Sanmarg) & Nepali (Himalaya Darpan) on 11.04.2013. The last date of submission of application at the office of WBSAP&CS is 29.04.2013 (Monday). All the applications will then be examined and shortlisted on the basis of experience and other required testimonials. The final selection will be made on the basis of an audition test of the shortlisted candidates. Following the final selection, the troupes will be awarded programmes as per the guidelines of National AIDS Control Organization (NACO) in this regard. Separate auditions (2 days' each) will be held for North Bengal and South Bengal districts tentatively during 2nd and 3rd week of May 2013 respectively.

To enable the selection process through audition, you are requested to kindly grace the audition sessions as a Judge or send your authorized representative for the evaluation of the performances of the participating folk troupes. The exact dates of auditions will be intimated shortly.
